


Problems with Wireless connection in the library?

- 1 Check that  is selected as your default wireless connection.
- 2 Check that the wireless system is working.
- 3 We recommend that Windows Wireless Network settings are enabled.
 1. Open “**Start -> Control Panel -> Network Connections**”.
 2. Press right button over “**Wireless Network Connections**” and select “**Properties**”.
 3. At “**Wireless Networks**” select Use Windows to configure my wireless network settings.
- 4 Your system should obtain an IP address and DNS server address automatically.
 1. Open “**Start -> Control Panel -> Network Connections**”.
 2. Press right button over “**Wireless Network Connections**” and select “**Properties**”.
 3. At “**General**” select **TCP/IP protocol**.
 4. Press on “**Properties**” and select “**Obtain an IP address automatically**” and “**Obtain DNS server address automatically**”.



Make sure you remember the old IP and DNS numbers because the system doesn't recover them after deleting.

- 5 If your firewall is running maybe you should close it.
- 6 If you have Windows Vista in some occasions DHCP BROADCAST fail and Windows Vista cannot connect.

To check this problem you can check the IP address. It should be similar than 10.83.95.114.

Once connected to ...

1 Open the web browser for internet connection

B Introduce data to enter as a UPC user or a guest.



When you get connected a pop-up window will show up. **Don't close it**, just minimize it otherwise your connection will fail.
