






Journal Impact Factor Journal Citation Reports



Open http://bibliotecnica.upc.edu/colleccions/bases-dades webpage. Inside the "Which resource do you want to search for" search box, type the words "Web of Science" and click on "Search".



Underneath, you will see all the databases from this provider.


Select Journal Citation Reports. You may login to access. Click on "Send" and write your username and password.

A. Find a list of journals about a certain topic sorted by impact factor

1. Select "Browse by Journal".



2. Click on "Select categories" and choose the topic you prefer.

Mind you to select the year when you published the article or the latest version available, depending on what you need.

Click on "Submit" at the bottom end.




3. To see more details, click on the title of the journal. In the "Rank" section you will see its category, position and quartile

B. Search for the impact factor of a journal

Enter in Journal Citation Reports and type the title of the journal.
 Select the right title from the list.



2. You will see the journal information with its impact factor.



3. In the "Rank" section you will see its category, position and quartile.

Mind you to select the year when you published the article or the latest version available, depending on what you need.









C. Find journals that have published about your topic and see their impact factor?


- 1. Open the webpage http://bibliotecnica.upc.edu/colleccions/bases-dades and select Web of Science.
- Check you are in "Web of Science Core Collection".
 Write your topic in English.
 Select "Topic".
 Click on "Search".



2. Once you are in the results screen, click on the journal title.



3. You will see its impact factor, category, position and quartile.



What else can you do in the results web page?

You can sort the results by number of times cited or by date.



Once you get the results, you can click on a journal title to see its impact factor, category, position and quartile.


You can also filter by title. Choose one or more from the "Source title" list on the left column and click on the "Refine" button.




You can also refine the results by language, type of document, etc.

Once you get the results, click on the journal title to see its impact factor, category, position and quartile.

✓ You can click on "Analyze results".



Select "Source Title". You will see the journal titles sorted by number of articles published about the topic you searched for.



Select the journals you like and click on "View results". Once you get the results, click on the journal title to see its impact factor, category, position and quartile.

If you want to publish an article in a journal, mind you to visit its webpage and read the instructions for authors.
